

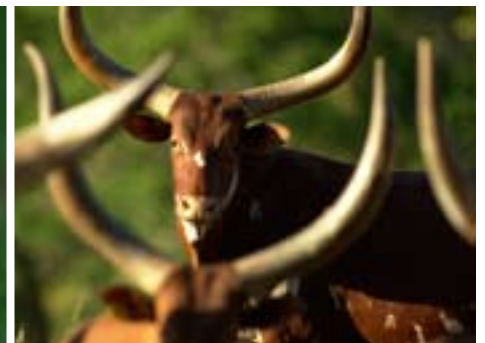
SafariWest FAQ

About Safari West

- ▶ **Not a zoo**, not a drive-through park, it's an Adventure—an African Wildlife Preserve and Tented Safari Camp where the whole family can experience over 400 exotic mammals and birds, nestled on 400 acres in the heart of California wine country.
- ▶ **Founded in 1979** as a private ranch for breeding and species propagation, Safari West soon added children's tours, and in 1993 opened its doors to adults. Peter Lang handles the larger animals, and his wife, Nancy, formerly of the San Francisco Zoo, is in charge of the aviary.
- ▶ **Why in the Wine County?**
The weather is ideal, the combination of grassland and forest similar to Africa, the neighbors are friendly, there is plenty of water, plus it's Paradise!
- ▶ **The ongoing mission** of Safari West is wildlife preservation through breeding, education, research and public interaction. Our non profit arm is Safari West Wildlife Foundation.
- ▶ **In 1982, Safari West** gained membership in the American Zoo and Aquarium Association, one of only six private facilities in North America to belong to that prestigious organization.

Tours and Tents

- ▶ **We host over sixty thousand** families, students and business travelers annually.
- ▶ **The tent camp adventure**—the only accommodation of its kind in North America. Safari West's Tent Camp Adventure treats our guests to a luxury African tent camp experience in the heart of California's Napa/Sonoma Wine country, with 31 luxury safari tent cabins and one cottage.
- ▶ **Tour capacity** is an average of 270 people per day during peak season not including private and group safaris. Lodging capacity—31 Safari Tent Cabins and one cottage.
- ▶ **Visitors spend an unforgettable morning** or afternoon in an open air Jeep safari vehicle tracking and learning all about exotic and endangered wildlife including cheetah, cape buffalo, springbok, eland, zebra, scimitar-horned oryx, addax, lechwe, lemurs and wildebeest.
- ▶ **Guests are also invited** to visit our walk-through aviary surrounded by brilliantly colored birds including Ross's turacos, hadada ibis and African spoonbills.
- ▶ **Private wine and cheese safaris** and photo safaris also may be arranged based upon availability. A sip of chardonnay pairs marvelously with a spot of cheetah.
- ▶ **Upon special arrangements**, guests can enjoy Special Private Animal Encounters such as Behind the Scenes tours, Cheetah Photo, Cheetah Presentations, Animal Presentations, plus Keeper of the Day.
- ▶ **Guests can be pampered** in the serenity of their own luxury tents with a Swedish massage with pressure point therapy.
